5. Entrants will provide approximately one and one-half (1 1/2) gallons of chili in a crockpot
6. Entries must be entered at a minimum temperature of 165 degrees.
7. Judging will be based on the following criteria: aroma and color, consistency, taste, and aftertaste.
8. Recipes are not required, but please bring a list of ingredients. No wild game.
9. Following the judging, chili will be served, and donations will be accepted.
