### **Categories**

Submissions to the fiber arts exhibition are open to ALL kinds of fiber art, except quilting, which should be submitted to the Quilt portion of the exhibition. Fiber artworks must be clean, finished, and not have been entered in a Montana Winter Fair exhibition previously. Categories include: knitting, crocheting, tatting, macrame, needlepunch, huckweaving, embroidery or cross stitch, weaving, roving, spinning, felting, sewing, rug making, and miscellaneous. We encourage youth participation, as well!

### **Pick Up**

Items may be picked up at the Lewistown Art Center during regular Art Center hours the week of March 7. Prompt retrieval is appreciated out of respect for the Art Center's space. If you would like your work returned to you by mail (at your own risk), please include the cost of shipping with your entry form.
